


COLLECTIVE NOUN



What is a collective noun is a very interesting question in English grammar. We can readdress this question by stating that some singular terms can be changed into plural, but we cannot readdress plural as a group as it doesn't define the quantity. Certain words tell us things, or people are in a group with different terms. These different terms are known as collective nouns.
